The objectives of this organization are:

To develop and advance the members' professional abilities in the administration of the *International Codes* and to insure the health, safety and welfare of all people in matters relating to building construction.

To unite the members in pursuit of code enforcement, for the betterment of the people in the area serviced by the Association.

To secure a closer official and personal relationship among Code Officials throughout the territory.

To promote higher professional and ethical standards in the field of building inspection and code enforcement.

To establish and maintain a good working relationship within the construction industry.

To encourage and provide a forum for the free exchange of ideas and information among its members to furnish information of an instructional nature to its members and to other interested and related parties.

To compile and disseminate building code and zoning information useful to the membership in the performance of their duties and responsibilities.

To promote continuing education and training.

MEMBERSHIP

There shall be three classes of membership: Active Member, Associate Member, and Honorary Member.

Active Member: Any person within Pennsylvania whose primary duties are the enforcement of building codes and related ordinances, and is employed by a state or local unit of government. An Active Member has all voting rights.

Associate Member: Any person(s), firms, company, or corporation having an interest in furthering the objectives and purposes of PA Association of Fire Code Officials. Such a member shall not hold an elective office. An Associate Member has no voting rights.

Honorary Membership may be conferred upon any person as an honorarium for outstanding service to the Association. Such a member shall hold no elected office nor be subject to payment of dues. Nominations for Honorary Member shall be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to an annual meeting. A favorable report by the Board of Directors and a majority vote of the Association at an annual meeting shall be necessary to elect.

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

Submit a completed and signed Association application form with fees covering the current years dues.

Upon receipt the Secretary shall forward the above to the Membership Committee Chair.

The Membership Committee shall review said application for correctness, qualifications, and criteria.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

The annual membership dues of the Association shall be as established by resolution of the general membership.

Dues shall be due on January 1st of each calendar year. For new members coming into the Association the last six months of the dues years, the membership fee shall also cover the following full year's dues.

Each member of the Association will be billed once a year by the Treasurer. Dues must be paid before January 1st to retain membership.

Any member not paying his dues for a period of more than one (1) year shall be reported by the Secretary to the Board of Directors for dismissal from membership of the Association.

The monies received shall be used to defray the expenses associated with the pursuit of the objectives as listed in Article II.

Members whose dues are current shall be considered in good standing.

ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the members shall be held at such place as the Board of Directors shall determine in the notice of meeting.

Purposes for which an annual meeting is to be held, additional to those prescribed by law, and by these bylaws, may be specified by the President, or by one or more members who are entitled to vote at the meeting.
